Litter bin update.

1.1 New bins have been delivered. The Parish Council ordered 19 full sized metal bins and 6 post mounted bins. During this month, the team will begin the process of installing new bins including changing bins over to prioritise metal bins in Freshbrook and Toothill.

1.2 The Parish office has received further requests for bins, however, it was previously agreed that no further bins would be purchased until all new bins were in situ. A number of red dog bins are in a state of deterioration so it is likely that these bins will need to be replaced in coming months. Bins are at risk of vandalism and theft so it would be prudent for the Parish to plan to have spares in store.

1.3 New bin locations were previously agreed as follows:

Full sized bins:

1. The Chesters footpath t junction
2. Corton Crescent footpath to Langstone Way (new bin half way down)
3. Ashington Way crossing to the Link Centre (behind Pharmacy)
4. Westlea/Toothill footbridge replace with 128 Tewkesbury Way
5. Bodiam Drive crescent (*consider post mounted if necessary*)
6. Rowton Heath Way bus stop opposite Oliver Tomkins
7. Great Western Way bus stop opp. Volvo garage
8. Sudeley Way (Holinshead Place bus stop)
9. Castleton Road bus stop
10. Bins 56, 57, 58 – wall mounted at Freshbrook Village Centre (possible recycle to Shaw Ridge Linear Park) remove and replace **x 2** full bins
11. Shaw Ridge linear park pathway
12. Gainsborough Way bus stops **x2** *full standing - installation allowing*
13. Additional large bin for Freshbrook Village Centre by pub exit to Worsley Road (move bin 100)
14. Full sized bin for Shaw Forest Park car park
15. Eastleaze Field Play Area
16. Swap 076 post mounted with one full bin
17. Hillmead Drive (lorries overnight parking)
18. Toothill Park subway to Blagrove

Post Mounted Bins:

19. Westlea Park – Moresby Close bridge
20. Bodiam Drive close to farmhouse
21. Bus stop opposite Shaw Village Centre
22. Sudeley Way footpath to Hay Lane
23. Shelfinch play area additional bin
24. Tewkesbury Way bus stop Westlea

1.4 A number of requests cannot be completed due to problems with the location. Sites requested that are not suitable:

- Wilmot Close bus stops x 2 – nowhere to mount bins and insufficient space on footway
- Hampton Drive school bus stop (*consider post mounted*)
- Worsley Road (opp. Windmill pub) – footway too narrow

1.5 Some bins need to be relocated slightly to better respond to footfall. Bins to relocate are as follows:

109 Langstone Way move to opposite side of the road by bus stop

117 move to footpath side of hedge on Stokesay Drive by junction box and path to Oakham/Kirkstall

Sponsored bins:

1.6 Two bins have been sponsored by McDonalds. These are to be located on Mead Way bus stop and footpath from Mc Donalds to Mannington Subway.
