Dear Clerk,

I am writing to you today to inform you of our proposals we have to try and accommodate this issue occurring on the Roundabout outside of WRc building. I am sure you are all aware but I will give you a brief description of the issues. Cyclists are joining the roundabout from the access road to the allotments travelling the wrong way around the roundabout causing near misses with WRc's staff vehicles.

I enclose a plan showing our current thoughts on measures that we could introduce in an effort to improve cyclist behaviour here. These consist of –

- Moving the give way lines forward to the junction itself – in recognition that this is a vehicle access road
- Orientating the give way lines to face the roundabout directly rather than obliquely – to emphasise the status of the roundabout
- Raising one of the sections of dropped kerb - to discourage cyclists from cutting the corner
- Additional signs on the roundabout itself - to emphasis the status of the island

Amendments to the yellow lines - to emphasis the status of the junction with the access road. This will obviously need a new TRO and consultation.

I am sure that you can appreciate that we are dealing with many requests for schemes on the highway and that we need to prioritise resources accordingly. Particular priority has to be given to the main road network and locations where there is already a record of injury collisions. I will however progress these proposals as part of our overall programme of works.

Please let me know your thoughts on these proposals.
