# 1. Services Work Completed (4 weekly update)

- 1.1 During the last four weeks, the team has progressed the following:
  - Return to grass cutting 18<sup>th</sup> September was the last cut but the mild dry weather has promoted growth
  - Leaf clearances across the Parish do let us know of any problem patches.
  - New bin to replace damage at Bloomsbury Park, bins replaced at the fisherman's car park, Peatmoor.
  - Attended Hedgefest at Park Farm
- 1.2 Play improvement work has been undertaken including
  - Removed wooden equipment at Whitehill Park
  - Drainage added to Whitehill park to assist with the introduction of new goal ends
  - Monitoring damage at Shelfinch rope swing
