Subject: Services Update

## 1. Services Work Completed (4 weekly update)

1.1 Noting the Christmas closure, the Parish Council team focused on litter and flytipping for two weeks around the festive period.

Routine work over the last four weeks includes:

- Fly tipping and bin emptying increase in waste collection due to the season
- Intensive clearance work at Cowdrey Close and Tintagel Close, Toothill due to large volume of littering from recycling collections
- Hedge and shrub cutting Toothill and now starting Freshbrook
- Routine play inspections (once weekly)

## 1.2 Play improvement work has been undertaken including

- Moss removal and edge scraping
- New swing hangers at Nine Elms
- New equipment ordered for Camden Close

## 1.3 **Project Work**

The team have completed

- completion of defibrillator installation
- monthly pick up after volunteer group litter picks
- supporting Shaw Fab group with tree removal
- support to Toothill Big Local with premises queries
- manual removal of falling/fallen trees ongoing across the Parish
- Christmas tree decorations in village centres
- Christmas event at Westlea Fire Station
- small tractor side arm broke and is being refitted
- tractor servicing
- mower cleaning and light servicing ready for the new season
- hand tool replacements
- · community pantry collections

### 1.5 **Requests for Service:**

The team have received a small number of requests from the public, mostly broken glass and litter. Complaint received about long grass.
